WEAPONS Forms kum do, etcetera

1. **PROCEDURE** - (same as tkd.forms) 2. **SPECIFICATIONS** - Weapons must be authentic to martial arts and must be protected from sharpness.

3. **STYLE** - Only the following weapons will be allowed:

Kai (oar), kama (no rope), katana / kum / boken, long bo, naginata, nunchaku, sai, tonfa. Each weapon has specific size and weight.

EXAMPLE - Long Bo: Construction - Must be hardwood, unadorned Length - Must be at least the height of the player and can be to a maximum of four (4) inches taller than the player.

4. if, **WEAPON BREAKS** - The player has five (5) minutes to replace it with the same or a different weapon or can complete the form with the broken weapon without penalty.

SELF DEFENSE will be judged (same as forms)

1. **PROCEDURE** - (same as forms)

2. **PROPS** - Only people and weapons can be used as props. No other props, music or skit dialogue.

3. **TIME LIMIT** - Up to three (3) minutes per performance is allowed from the time the player enters the ring.

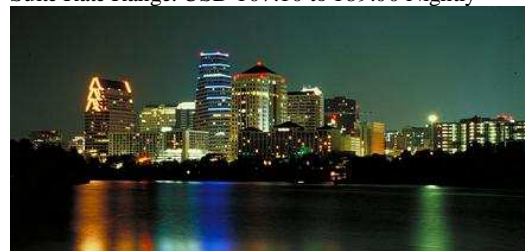

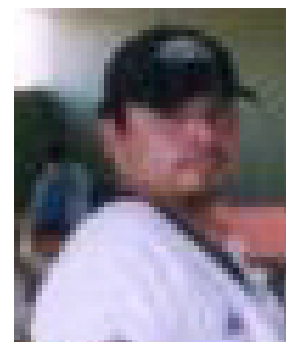

Coming from North: Coming Dallas Fort Worth and Oklahoma on IH 35 in Austin take the 290 East exit towards Houston go 8 miles the Gym is on the right.

Coming from South: Mexico Monterey Laredo on IH 35 go past Austin Down Town, go 5 miles then take the 290 East exit towards Houston go 8 miles the Gym is on the right.
